5.3 New name - Hamilton Youth City Council

- Youth City Councillors approved by those in attendance
- Establish mentorships between Councillors, Mayor, and HYCC members
- Build relationships between youth and Councillors from each of the Wards
- **New website and logo** deferred until a membership recruitment takes place. Support from graphic team may be available to draft a logo.
- **5.5 HYAC's / HYCC's official Terms of Reference** A meeting is scheduled for Monday March 9th, 6-7:30pm. Place TBD. Youth and adult allies will work on a draft of the proposed ToR for HYCC for Council approval by April.
- 5.6 Movement under the Department All in attendance agreed to initiate the process to move HYAC from the Advisory Committee structure to Community Services Department. Formal passing required by Council. Budget, for move to department is available as are the same resources and supports. It is also important to note that the youth committee/council would be able to return to the Advisory Model if the committee decides to do so.
- 5.7 HSR Information for McMaster University Mark to provide Jackson with contact information. Jackson to inquire with the HSR about the buses most used by Mac students. Mac and Mohawk students use a photo ID card with a semester sticker applied to it. No electronic swiping of bus passes (visual check by the driver) therefore bus use by students would be difficult to track.
- 5.8 Youth Week Hamilton the community will be encouraged to acknowledge youth during Youth Week Hamilton by hosting events of interest to youth across the City. Mark and René to meet and finalize a community info bulletin on Thursday Feb. 19th. HYAC will not be hosting a launch or coordinating a formal event/activity of their own but will provide communication to the public about events being held.
